The Diesel & Electric Preservation Group was formed in 1973 with the primary objective of preserving one of British Railway's Class 35 'Hymek' locomotives built by the Beyer Peacock Company in Manchester. From 1961 they were used on the Western Region of British Railways on both passenger and freight services but by 1973 initial withdrawals were already underway. Thus there was a sense of urgency to raise funds to buy one of the dwindling numbers of locomotives left. By 1975 we successfully bought 'Hymek' D7017 for restoration and future service on the West Somerset Railway. Since then we have become a charity keeping Heritage Diesel locomotives alive today running on the West Somerset Railway.
